

Plastic Pallet Recycling Guide

Plastic pallets can be made from a variety of materials and not all can be recycled by CLAW Environmental. The following guide will help identify those we can recycle and those we cannot.

Pallets which CLAW Environmental have the capacity to recycle are those made from high density polyethylene (HDPE or ②) or polypropylene (PP or ③) These pallets will generally have the abbreviation or the polymer identification marked on them during manufacture. Some will have PE and PP stamped on them with a small arrow pointing to the polymer they are made from.

Pallets which CLAW Environmental WILL accept are:

- those with polymer identification marks showing HDPE (2) or PP (5)
- sorted into polymer type, ie stacks of HDPE or PP
- clean and free of any non plastic pallet material(s)

Pallets which CLAW Environmental **WILL NOT** accept are:

- those which have no identification markings, or are identified as being made from other polymers.
- Have metal screws, bolts or other attachments
- Have metal reinforcing bars in their structure

There are some pallets which are acceptable which do not have identification marks. If you think you have pallets like this feel free to email us a photo for comment.
